Weed Scenarios	Pre-emergent and early post-emergent annual grass and broadleaf weeds	Tough-to-control weeds like fleabane, Acacia, Eucalyptus, sticky nightshade	Crack and crevice, gravel or soil sites around infrastructure: pre-emergent weeds like crabgrass, fleabane, wintergrass, thistles
Tank-Mix Rates	Esplanade Herbicide 150mL/ha + Method 240SL Herbicide 0.65-1.3L/ha + glyphosate (for burndown)	Esplanade Herbicide 150mL/ha + Method 240SL Herbicide 1.3L/ha + glyphosate (for burndown)	Esplanade Herbicide 30mL/100L + glyphosate (for burndown)

Do not apply within the root zone of desirable trees or vegetation; this root zone can be extended well beyond the tree canopy.

*Hard residual bareground applications (industrial sites where long-term bareground is desired and no desirable trees or sensitive vegetation are nearby or present).

**Do not use herbicides and tank-mix partners that may impact nearby sensitive and desirable vegetation, such as ornamental beds and over-story trees that are in proximity to the treatment area.

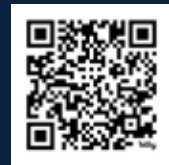
