



# PPE requirements vs. other pyrethroid insecticides

Product	PPE Requirements
Suspend PolyZone®	Long-sleeved shirt, long pants, chemical-resistant gloves, socks and shoes during mixing, loading, application, cleanup and repair. DO NOT apply to overhead areas or in confined spaces without appropriate respiratory and eye protection.
Demand® CS	Workers should wear long pants, long-sleeved shirts, and chemical-resistant boots and gloves. In addition, during mixing, loading, cleanup and repair activities, workers must also wear chemical-resistant gloves and safety goggles or a face shield. Avoid touching face with contaminated gloves or clothing. Wash gloves before removal. <b>For applications using mechanically-pressurized or power operated hand-held equipment, also wear chemical-resistant coveralls and a respirator with a NIOSH-approved organic vapour removing cartridge with a prefilter approved for pesticides OR a NIOSH-approved canister approved for pesticides during mixing, loading and application.</b> DO NOT handle more than 7.2 L per day. DO NOT apply to overhead areas or in confined spaces without appropriate respiratory and eye protection.
Dragnet® FT	<p>Applicators using handheld mistblowers (i.e. equipment which delivers a spray with a volume median diameter (VMD) of 50-100 µm) must wear protective eyewear (goggles or face shield), chemical-resistant coveralls with a chemical-resistant hood over long pants, and long-sleeved shirt, chemical-resistant gloves, socks, chemical-resistant footwear, and a respirator with a NIOSH-approved organic vapour removing cartridge with a prefilter approved for pesticides OR a NIOSH-approved canister approved for pesticides during mixing, loading, application, cleanup and repair.</p> <p>Applicators using mechanically-pressurized handgun application equipment, must wear protective eyewear (goggles or face shield), a respirator with a NIOSH-approved organic vapour removing cartridge with a prefilter approved for pesticides OR a NIOSH-approved canister approved for pesticides, cotton coveralls over long-sleeved shirt, long pants, chemical-resistant gloves, socks, and shoes during mixing, loading, application, cleanup and repair. Applicators using other application equipment, including manual pump spray devices, must wear protective eyewear (goggles or face shield), a respirator with a NIOSH-approved organic vapour removing cartridge with a prefilter approved for pesticides OR a NIOSH-approved canister approved for pesticides, long pants, long-sleeved shirt, chemical-resistant gloves, shoes, and socks during mixing, loading, application, cleanup.</p>
