SYMPTOMS OF POISONING:

Bleeding from the gums and nose, bleeding under the skin, pallor, haemorrhage into and around elbow and knee joints. Blood in urine and faeces.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

Remove patient from source of poisoning and keep him/her quiet and reassured. Take patient IMMEDIATELY to the nearest physician. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Administer 5 mg/kg Vit. K₁ intravenously on the first day, followed by another administration of the same dose if the Quick time does not normalise a few hours after the first injection. Follow up with 5 mg/kg/day orally on the second and following days. The duration of the treatment is generally between 10 and 15 days. In severe cases give small transfusions of fresh blood.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: USE ONLY AS DIRECTED.

For use in the home, on the farm and industrial premises. **In household setting, tamper-proof bait boxes are recommended.** **Finale® Pellets** can kill rats and mice after a single feed. Death of rodents will take 4-12 days. Effective against warfarin resistant rats and mice. **Prevent contamination of water ways.**

If bait boxes are deployed, the following product information (i.e., label and/or leaflet) should be properly labelled:

- "do not move or open";
- "contains a rodenticide";
- product name or Act 36 of 1947 registration number;
- active substance(s) and
- "in case of incident, call a poison centre.

Norway- and Roof Rats

Place **Finale® Rat and Mouse Pellets** in a covered bait station to prevent access by children and domestic animals.

Place 50 - 75 g **Finale® Rat and Mouse Pellets** per bait station every 5 - 10 m along walls or ratruns, in rat burrows and in sheltered areas where rats are known to live or feed. Bait points should be inspected and replenished every 7 days until feeding ceases.

Mice

Place 15 - 20 g **Finale® Rat and Mouse Pellets** per bait station every 2 - 4 m along walls or runways, in nests and in sheltered areas where mice are known to live or feed. The single feed action of **Finale® Rat and Mouse Pellets** is particularly effective against mice with their small appetites and sporadic feeding behaviour.
